NO sharing food

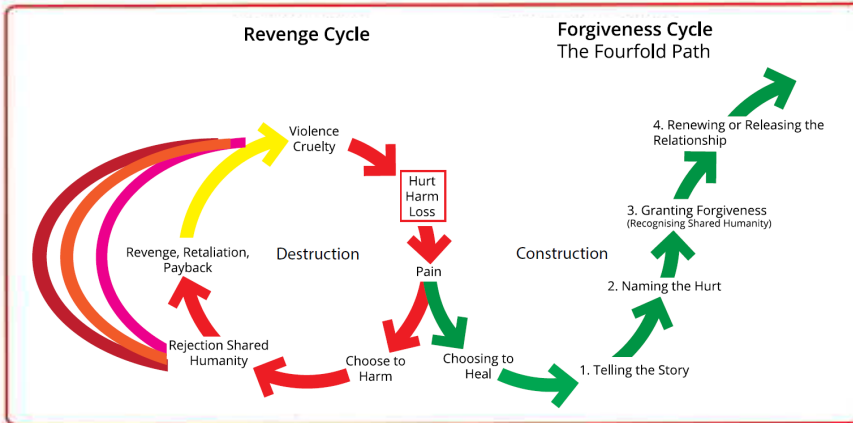
Uniform

The first decision directs all action and is tied to culture and beliefs. The moral, ethical path is to heal, to engage all parties and to recognise shared humanity. This first decision made by the authority is crucial and describes the culture as kind or unkind, as enabling or disabling to all parties.

To harm is destructive and disengages parties from the obligation to be responsible for the outcome whereas to heal engages parties in the obligation to be responsible. To harm leads to a lose lose. To heal leads to a win win.
